June 1 is filing deadline for city, school elections

Kingman County residents will go to the polls this fall to elect city and school board leaders but the deadline for candidates to file for office is noon on June 1.

All seven incorporated cities in the county will elect at least three council/commission members. USD 331 Kingman-Norwich voters will elect three school board members and USD 332 Cunningham also will elect three members.

Candidates must file at the County Clerk's office in the courthouse, 130 N. Spruce in Kingman. There is a \$20 filing fee.

If needed, a primary election would be held on Aug. 1. Citizens must register to vote no later than July 11 to vote in the primary. The General Election will be Nov. 7, with a voter registration deadline of Oct. 17. Not sure whether you are registered to vote or your information is current? You can check your registration via a link on the Kingman County website, kingmancoks.org. The site also has the voter registration form and a link to a list of acceptable proof of citizenship documents. Proof of citizenship is required for first-time voter registration.

Advance voting will again be available. If a Primary Election is required, advance in-person voting will begin July 25 during regular office hours in the County Clerk's office and will conclude at noon on July 31. Mail advance ballots may be requested and must be returned by the close of polls on Election Day.

Here is a list of the positions up for election and the current office holders.

Kingman. Three commission members: Dick Neville, Stan Hacker and Mark Arensdorf.

Norwich. Three council members: Tim Magruder, Dean Murray and Brady Shipley.

Penalosa. Mayor: David Reppert; Five council members: Jimmy Webster, Teresa Winter, Ben Oak, Daniel Smith and Mike Winter.

Spivey. Mayor: Michael C. Buss; Five council members: Scott Hoffman, Addie Holloway, Lester Holloway, Patricia Morfitt and Julia Hoffman.

Zenda. Mayor: Andrew Kostner; Five council members: Dale A. Swope, Wayne Culp, Johnna J. Raida, Lawrence Thimesch and Dan Swope.

USD 331 Kingman-Norwich. Three seats – Position 1: Tammy Schrag; Position 5: Andrea Shipley; Position 6: Jeff Samuelson.

USD 332 Cunningham. Three seats, all at large: Joyce Gridley, Renee Ruckle and Kurt Preisser.
