Sealed proposals will be received at the office of the County Clerk, Kingman County Courthouse, Kingman, Kansas, until 11:00 a.m., on June 5, 2017 at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read aloud for:

2017 SURFACE OVERLAY PROGRAM - PART III

The County will accept bids for two alternate project segments on RS 607. The County will make the decision on which alternate project segment to award based on the amount of the project bids received from contractors.

Project RS 607

Alternate #1

The project consists of a 1 inch leveling course and a 1½” surface course on a segment of RS 607 beginning 4’ east of the SE Corner, Section 5, Township 27 South, Range 10 West and extending 3.2 miles to the east ending 69’ east of the SW Corner, Section 1, Township 27 South, Range 10 West. The project is based on a 23.0’ wide surface.

The bid quantities for the project consist of the following total approximate quantities of work:

Alternate #2

The project consists of a 1 inch leveling course and a 1½” surface course on a segment of RS 607 beginning 4’ east of the SE Corner, Section 5, Township 27 South, Range 10 West and extending 6 miles to the east, ending 75’ east of the SW Corner, Section 4, Township 27 South, Range 9 West. The project is based on a 23.0’ wide surface.

The bid quantities for Alternate #2 consist of the following total approximate quantities of work:

All equipment, materials and workmanship must be in accordance with the Standard Specifications for State Road and Bridge Construction of the Kansas Department of Transportation, 2007 Edition, with all Supplemental Specifications and the Special Provisions that include applicable local construction standards and procedures as provided with the contract documents.

Copies of the contract documents will be on file at the Kingman County Clerk's office, Kingman County Courthouse, Kingman, Kansas, the office of the County Engineer, and in the office of Schwab Eaton, Consulting Engineers, 1125 Garden Way, Manhattan, Kansas 66502. Bidders may secure a set of such documents (except the Standard Specs., 2007 Ed) for the project from Schwab Eaton with a deposit of \$75.00. No refund will be made for returned plans. Three additional sets of documents (except Standard Specs., 2007 Ed.) will be furnished to the successful bidder. Electronic copies of the construction documents are available at www.schwab-eaton.com with a \$45.00 paid subscription.

All bidders must be prequalified with the Kansas Department of Transportation for the type and amount of work covered under this contract.

A bid deposit in the form of certified check on a solvent Kansas bank or a satisfactory bid bond in an amount equal to five percent of the total larger bid price of the two alternates must accompany the bid.

Bidders shall direct all questions concerning the plans and contract documents to Schwab Eaton.

Bidders will be required to furnish the number of calendar days in the Proposal necessary to complete the work from the date of the Notice to Proceed. A start date no later than September 18, 2017 is required.

No bidder may withdraw his bid for a period of 30 days after the date of the opening of bids.

The bidder to whom a contract is awarded will be required to furnish performance and statutory bonds acceptable to Kingman County, each in the amount of the total contract price in conformity with the requirements of the contract documents.

The right is reserved by the County to reject any or all bids and to waive any informalities therein, to determine which is the lowest responsible bid most suitable to the County and to approve the bonds.
